Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of the impugned order dated 22.02.2019 passed by learned Judge, Special Court, Moga in FIR No. 05 dated 07.01.2016 under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, 1985 registered as Police Station City Moga, whereby the application moved by the respondent-State under Section 311 Cr.P.C. for summoning the prosecution witness was allowed at the belated stage of the case when the arguments of the defence was over and the case was rest for the delivery of the judgment.

Learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition only with a limited prayer that while examining Jaswinder Singh-DSP as PW-7, the petitioner be granted opportunity to cross-examine him.
