The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. Seeking directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to provide protection to the lives and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents No. 4 and 5.

It has been averred that the date of birth of petitioner No.1 is 6.2.2001 and of petitioner No. 2 is 4.5.1998 and copies of Aadhar Cards of both the petitioners to this effect are attached at Annexures P1 and P2 respectively.

It has been submitted that marriage of the petitioners was solemnized on 26.2.2019 as per Hindu rites in a Mandir at Panchkula. The photographs of marriage are attached as Annexures P3. Private respondents No.4 and 5 are opposed the marriage as the petitioners had performed the marriage without their consent. The petitioners have submitted representation dated 26.2.2019 (Annexure P4) to respondent No.2 seeking protection of their lives and liberty at the hands of the private respondents.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioners and without

expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the validity of the marriage and the age of the petitioners and keeping in view the binding precedent of the Hon'ble Apex Court in Lata Singh v. State of UP and another, 2006(2) SCC (Criminal) 478, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to look into the said issue and take necessary action in accordance with law.
