Petitioner seeks parole for four weeks from 4.3.2019 to 1.4.2019 under Section 3 (1) (a) of the Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release), 1988 for treatment of his wife who has to undergo eye surgery on 6.3.2019.

It comes out that petitioner has not approached the jail authorities nor any adverse order has been passed against him. Though it is claimed that he was orally told that petitioner being hard core prisoner, cannot be released on parole.

In any case, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the surgery has already taken place on 6.4.2019. It was a cataract surgery which is a minor surgery for which the presence of the petitioner is not required.

No ground to release the petitioner on parole is made out.

Dismissed.
