1. Petitioner-Dildar Ahmad, seeks grant of anticipatory bail in a case registered vide FIR No.30, dated 7.2.2019, registered at Police Station Women, District Yamuna Nagar, under Sections 498-A, 406, 323, 377 and 354 IPC.
2. During the course of pendency of this petition, the parties were referred to Mediation and Conciliation Centre, of this Court which has yielded results.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has informed that as per the settlement reached at amongst the parties, the parties shall get their marriage dissolved and that the petitioner is to pay an amount of ₹7 lacs in all, out of which an amount of ₹5 lacs had already been paid to the complainant vide Demand Draft dated 7.10.2019, a copy of which has been furnished to this court today.
4. The aforestated position is not disputed by learned counsel for the complainant.
5. In view of the fact that the parties have amicably resolved their issues, custodial interrogation of the petitioner is certainly not warranted. The petition, as such, is accepted and interim directions issued vide order dated 9.4.2019 are made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner shall appear and join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
