Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.01 dated 01.01.2019 under Sections 323, 341, 379-B, 506, 427, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Jagraon, District Ludhiana.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 05.03.2019:-

“.....Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that as per the allegations in the FIR, which was got registered by brother-in-law of the petitioner namely Harpreet Singh, i.e. sister's husband, the petitioner had caused him injuries. It is further submitted that, in fact, on the date of occurrence, the petitioner has returned back from New Delhi, after leaving the wife of Sukhjinder Singh @ Sunny (his co-brother) at Airport and on the date of incident, there

is no occasion for the petitioner to to Ghaggar i.e. the place of residence of Sukhjinder Singh @ Sunny. It is further argued that the allegations against the petitioner, that he has taken away some amount and gold chain, is only to put pressure on him as he was complaining maltreatment and harassment of his sister, who is married to the complainant.....”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation. It is further submitted that during the investigation, the police has deleted Section 379-B IPC.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Jarnail Singh, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 05.03.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
