The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail.

On 8.3.2019, the following order was passed :-

“ This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.286 dated 20.09.2018 registered under Sections 307/34 IPC and Sections 25, 54 & 59 of the Arms Act at Police Station Narnaund, Hansi.

Custody certificate filed in Court dated 07.03.2019 by Shamsher Singh Dahiya, Superintendent of Prison, Central Jail No.1, Hissar, Haryana is taken on record. As per the custody certificate, the petitioner has undergone the actual custody of more than 5 months.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the matter has been settled.

Counsel appearing for the complainant has accepted the factum of compromise.

Learned Deputy Advocate General states that the

investigating officer, who is present in court, has no knowledge about this compromise and seeks an adjournment.

Adjourned to 12.03.2019.”

Today, learned AAG Haryana, on instructions from ASI Surinder, states that it has been verified that the matter has been compromised.

In these circumstances, without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner as well as the fact that the matter has been compromised, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending C.Ms, if any, also stand disposed of.
