lakh in some nationalized bank in the name of petitioner No.2 – Arti Kumari

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within a period of two months from today. The said FDR shall be for a period of five years. Petitioner No.1 is directed to deposit copy of the FDR in the Registry within a period of two months from today. In case, he fails to do so, Registry is directed to list the matter on 15.05.2019.
