Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.11 dated 27.01.2019 under Sections 406, 323, 498-A, 377, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Women, Ambala, District Ambala.

Power of attorney filed on behalf of respondent No.2 today in the Court, is taken on record.

The marriage between the petitioner and complainant-respondent No.2 was solemnized on 19.10.2018. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that during the pendency of the present petition, matter has been compromised between the parties and a compromise-deed dated 06.03.2019 is reduced into writing. He has further argued that in terms of

the compromise dated 06.03.2019, a sum of Rs.13 lacs has already been given to complainant-respondent No.2 and the remaining amount would be paid in terms of the compromise. Petitioner is in custody since 07.02.2019.

Learned counsel for complainant-respondent No.2 admits the very factum of the compromise dated 06.03.2019.

In view of the fact that the matter has been compromised between the parties vide compromise dated 06.03.2019 and the petitioner is in custody since 07.02.2019, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is admitted on regular bail, subject to furnishing of his bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.
