This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR No.98 dated 29.04.2013, under Sections 283, 160, 188 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 3 of the Prevention of Damage to Public Property Act, 1984, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Bathinda (Annexure P-1).

Notice of motion was issued on 19.05.2016 and pursuant to the same, a reply by way of affidavit of Yogesh Kumar, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, City-II, Bathinda dated 10.11.2016 was filed on behalf of respondent-State. As per the reply, the investigation in the case was completed and the final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. was presented before the Illaqa Magistrate, Bathinda on 02.04.2016.

During the course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioners does not dispute this fact that the final report is yet to be considered by the trial Court.

Considering the above, this Court does not find any reason to

invoke the inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C. at this stage as the petitioners can effectively raise all the grounds raised in this petition before the trial Court at the time of consideration of final report.

The petition is disposed off.
