The petitioners have approached this Court by way of instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, for issuance of a writ in the nature of *certiorari*, for setting aside the possession notice dated 28.12.2018 (**Annexure P-6**) issued under Section 13(4) of the Securitization and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Securities Interest Act, 2002.

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition along with miscellaneous application with liberty to the petitioners either to approach the respondent-Bank or take recourse to the alternative remedies as may be available to them, in accordance with law.

3. Accordingly, the writ petition along with miscellaneous application (Civil Misc. No.4670 of 2019) stand dismissed as withdrawn. It shall, however, be open to the petitioners to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to them, in accordance with law.
