The allegations against the petitioner-Lalit @ Mota which have been levelled by the complainant-mother of a girl, aged around 15 years. It is alleged that one, Rohit and his friend, Manoj @ Moja/non-applicant/accused, used to stalk her daughter and even tried to forcibly stop her on her way and talk to her and criminally intimidated her by means of a knife, leading to the registration of the present case and arrest of the petitioner on 26.07.2018.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that the name of the petitioner does not figure in the allegations of the

complainant and has been belatedly added at a subsequent stage.

The learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Sunita Police Station Kundli, District Sonipat, has opposed the grant of bail on the ground that it is during the course of investigation, the name of the petitioner has cropped up and if allowed bail, he might influence the trial.

Appreciating the submissions of the two sides, the petitioner is behind the bars since long time. The fact that he is neither named in the FIR and his name has cropped up at a later stage, the present petition is allowed, as, culpability, if any, shall be determined at the trial. This Court is of the opinion that it would serve no useful purpose to further detain the petitioner in custody. Accordingly, he is ordered to be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate/Ilalaqa Magistrate of the Court concerned.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
