Application sent by Manpreet Kaur to Hon'ble the Chief Justice was treated as Criminal Writ Petition and taken on judicial side.

In compliance of the order dated 06.03.2019 passed by this Court, Warrant Officer has submitted his report.

I have gone through the report wherein it is mentioned that Amrik Singh was not detained at the time when the Warrant Officer had visited the spot. Rather, as per the allegations in the complaint, Amrik Singh was picked up by the police on 19.02.2019 and was kept for three days. This finding of fact is to be decided by the trial Court on the basis of evidence. The Warrant Officer cannot go into these allegations. Detenue- Amrik Singh himself stated that he is on anticipatory bail in some FIR case.

In view of the above facts, no further action is required in this petition.
