Prayer in the above mentioned petition is for quashing of FIR No.226 dated 22.11.2017 under sections 148, 149, 323, 324 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act registered at Police Station Sadar, District Sirsa and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of the compromise.

As per the report submitted by the trial Court, none of the parties have appeared to record their statements.

Even subsequent to the receiving of the report from the trial Court, the case has been adjourned twice. There was no representation on behalf of the parties on the last date of hearing and even today, there is no representation on their behalf.
