The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of the order dated 25.9.2018, vide which, direction was issued to look into the grievances of the petitioner.

Compliance report by way of affidavit of Gurpreet Singh Bhullar, IPS Commissioner of Police, Police Commissionerate Jalandhar dated 1.5.2019 filed in Court is taken on record. As per the same, the matter was considered and petitioner has been found entitled for amount due to him towards retiral benefits i.e. family pension, DCRG, Ex-gratia grant, leave encashment and new pension systems corpus (NPS). The same has been granted. Detail of the same has been mentioned in para 5 of the report at length. It is not disputed that the payment towards items at Sr. Nos.(i) and (ii) as mentioned in para 5 has still not been deposited in the account of the petitioner.

Needful be done within four weeks.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.

In case, the petitioner is forced to revive the contempt petition,
the responsible respondent shall personally be liable for heavy penalty of
₹50,000/-.
