TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA.J (Oral)

The instant petition was filed seeking a Mandamus for the Haryana Board of School Education to issue to the petitioner a Roll Number so as to facilitate her to participate in the 10+2 Examination.

Case of the petitioner was that she is a student of 10+2 and pursuing her study in the non-medical stream with the respondent no.3 school. It had been asserted that on account of an omission and mistake on the part of the school authorities the enrollment return which was to be submitted by the last date i.e. 18.11.2018 was sent by the school only on 25.1.2019. Counsel has referred to documents placed on record at Annexure P-1 and in terms of which the enrollment form was accepted by the respondent-Board upon deposit of Rs.2,000/- as late fee. On the same date i.e. 6.2.2019 the school had submitted the examination forms for the 10+2 examination which were to commence on 7.3.2019.

The instant petition had come up for preliminary hearing on 5.3.2019 and while issuing notice of motion, interim directions had been issued to the respondent-Board to issue to the petitioner the Roll Number so

as to take the 10+2 examination scheduled from 7.3.2019 pertaining to the Academic Session 2018-2019.

In compliance of the interim directions the Roll Number had been issued by the respondent-Board and petitioner had appeared in the 10+2 examination.

On a previous date, counsel representing the respondent-Board had been directed to produce the result of the 10+2 examination in which the petitioner had been provisionally permitted to appear.

During the Course of hearing today, Mr. Deepak Balyan, Advocate representing the respondent-Board has furnished for perusal of this Court the result sheet of the Senior Secondary Regular Examination March, 2019 pertaining to the petitioner and who had appeared under Roll Number 3019445635. The final result/GPA has been reflected as 07.20 (Qualified).

Counsel representing the Board does not object to the prayer as regards declaration of the result of the petitioner for the 10+2 examination and for the same to be put in public domain.

Accordingly, the result/marks sheet of the petitioner in pursuance to her participation in 10+2 examination be released in her favour as also the result be posted on the website of the respondent-Board.

No further directions are required to be passed.

Petition is disposed of.
