This petition has been filed under Section 438 for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No 124 dated 13.11.2018 registered under Sections 323, 324, 326, 307, 148 and 149 IPC (offence under Section 326 and 307 IPC added later on) at P.S. Sadar Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that similarly situated co-accused have already been granted anticipatory bail by this Court vide order dated 26.2.2019 passed in **CRM-M No.7381-2019**. He further stated that the petitioner has been attributed simple injuries.

Learned Deputy Advocate General, on instructions from ASI Kuldeep Singh has accepted that the petitioner is on same footing as other co-accused and simple injuries were attributed to the present petitioner.

I see no reason to take a different view.

Anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the same terms as in
CRM-M No.7381-2019.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal
miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
