Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not press the present petition and would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Additional District Judge, Amritsar (for short, the Trial Court) to expeditiously dispose of the petition filed by the petitioner under Section 11 read with Section 5 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 for annulment of the marriage between the petitioner and the respondent.

Since the aforesaid petition was filed by the petitioner about one and a half years ago and a direction to dispose of the same expeditiously would not prejudice either party to the *lis*, the Trial Court is requested to expeditiously dispose of the petitioner's aforesaid petition, of course, after giving adequate opportunities to both parties to lead their respective evidence in accordance with law.

If the respondent is aggrieved by this order, she is at liberty to approach this Court through an appropriate application.
