Both the learned counsel submitted that they may be permitted to withdraw these petitions with liberty to approach the trial Court again mainly to stress upon their arguments that they have been falsely implicated as would be evident from the CCTV footage preserved in the trial Court, which clearly shows that infact the petitioners had been taken away by the police one day prior to the lodging of the FIR and the vehicle in which they

were taken had passed through the toll plaza, the details of which were captured in the CCTV footage showing that the vehicle in question was driven by Head Constable Harvinder Singh, who is cited as witness No.6 in the list of witnesses.

In view of the aforesaid submission the present petitions are dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.

In case, any fresh application for grant of bail is filed before the trial Court and the aforesaid ground is taken therein, the learned trial Court shall dispose of the same expeditiously while also taking into account the contentions raised in the application including the contention regarding the CCTV footage.
