By filing this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No.04 dated 04.01.2018, registered under Sections 420, 406, 506, 120-B of Indian Penal code at Police Station Chhachhrauli, District Yamunanagar.

The allegations against the petitioner and seven other co-accused are that on the promise of securing a job for the complainant, they received a sum of Rs.1.5 lac. Vide order dated 30.05.2018, it was directed that in case, the petitioner deposits an amount of Rs.75,000/- and thereafter surrenders before the Court below, then he shall be granted interim bail. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the said amount has been deposited vide receipt dated 18.06.2018, a photocopy of which has been produced in the Court today. Vide order dated 04.12.2018, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

On instructions from police official, learned State counsel states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed. The order dated 04.12.2018 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
