Petitioners have preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.17 dated 05.12.2017, registered under Sections 498-A and 406 of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'IPC') at Police Station Woman, District Ferozepur.

Serious allegations have been levelled against the petitioners with regard to demand of dowry and even complete articles of *istridhan* have not been recovered. Efforts were made by this court for an amicable settlement, but all in vain.

Keeping in view the seriousness of the offence, this court is of the view that the petitioners are not entitled for the concession of anticipatory bail.

Petition is dismissed accordingly.
