Petitioner-Jagga Singh has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C for quashing of FIR No.78 dated 01.08.2015 registered under Sections 420 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Division No.8 (Kailash Chowk), District Ludhiana.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed that after completion of investigation, final report was submitted and the charges were framed against the petitioner on 28.07.2017. Even the prayer for discharge was declined by the trial Court and the said order was never challenged by the petitioner.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the complainant has further apprised the Court that considering the evidence on record, application filed by prosecution under Section 319 Cr.P.C was also allowed.

The factual aspects are not disputed by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Considering the advanced stage of the trial, this Court does not find any reason to invoke the inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

Petition is dismissed.
