The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.241 dated 08.12.2018, under Sections 307, 326, 148 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station City Phagwara, District Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the injury attributed to the petitioner is on the left arm of the complainant which is simple in nature. Now the complainant has fully recovered from that injury. The injury for which offence under Section 326, IPC has been added, is attributed to the co-accused, namely, Harpreet Singh @ Seetu Walia who has been granted ad interim anticipatory bail by the Coordinate bench of this Court in CRM-M-10673 of 2019 on 8.3.2019. The petitioner is in custody since 10.12.2018.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Baldev Singh states that investigation has been completed but no witness has been examined so far and there are two other cases of similar nature against the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner

is on bail in those cases.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the injury attributed to the petitioner is on the non-vital part of the body, he is in custody since 10.12.2018 and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant him regular bail.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing requisite bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
