1. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners were attacked by some unknown person regarding which FIR No.30 dated 9.2.2019 under Sections 307/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25/27 of Arms Act, Police Station Tarsikka, District Tarn Taran was lodged. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that they still apprehend threats to their lives & liberty and that although a representation P-7 has been made but the same is still pending with the police.
2. Having heard learned counsel for the petitioners, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Inspector General

of Police, to look into the matter and to dispose of representation (Annexure P-7) expeditiously. In case, the allegations made therein are found to be well-founded then necessary steps warranted under law be taken thereupon at the earliest.

3. A copy of this order along with copy of the representation (Annexure P-7) be sent to respondent No.3-Inspector General of Police, Amritsar so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
