The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 7, dated 26.01.2019, under Sections 307, 427, 506 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code ('IPC' - for short); Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Fatehgarh Churian, District Batala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that he along with others had fired outside the house of the complainant. He, however, contends that the petitioner was not recorded in the CCTV footage. He further contends that no one was injured in the occurrence. He also contends that the petitioner is not involved in any other case and is in custody since 26.01.2019.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Baljinder Singh is not in a position to controvert the submission made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner is in custody for over 2 ½ months, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
