AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Lachhman Singh, O/o Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda states that decision on the legal notice has been taken and petitioners have been found entitled to a sum of ₹9,45,246/-, same would be credited in the account of the petitioners within two weeks from today.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that detail of the calculation has not been provided.

Learned State counsel undertakes that detailed calculation would be provided within four weeks from today.

In view of statement made, learned counsel for the

petitioners states that no cause of action survives for pursuing contempt petition, however, seeks liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law, if aggrieved of the calculation and for claiming interest on delayed payment.

In view of above, the contempt petition is disposed of with liberty as prayed for.

However, in case statement made today is not adhered to, petitioners would be at liberty to revive the contempt petition.
