The petitioners have approached this Court under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, inter alia for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the notices dated 19.07.2018 (Annexure P-6), dated 29.11.2018 (Annexure P-7) under Section 13(2) and 13(4) of the Securitization and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002 and sale notice dated 04.02.2019 (Annexure P-11) passed by the respondent-bank.

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that he may be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioners to avail the alternative remedies as are available to it, in accordance with law.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. However, it shall be open to the petitioners to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to it, in accordance with law.
