This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.25 dated 13.1.2019 registered under Sections 379-A IPC, 1860 at police station City Yamuna Nagar, District Yamuna Nagar.

Custody certificate dated 6.3.2019 by way of affidavit of Dr. Rajeev-Dsp, Deputy Superintendent, District Prison- Yamuna Nagar- Haryana has been filed on behalf of the respondent-State, the same is taken on record. Copy has been supplied to the opposite counsel. As per the custody certificate the petitioner has been in custody for 1 month and 21 days on that date.

Learned AAG on instructions from SI Omveer Singh has confirmed that the affidavits Annexures P-2 and P-3 have been filed by the complainant.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, keeping in view the above facts and the period of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner, I deem it appropriate to grant regular bail to the petitioner. Ordered accordingly, Bail to the satisfaction of the concerned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
