The petitioner has made an innocuous prayer for seeking a direction to respondent No. 2 to conclude the hearing of the Case No. 26/7 VCL titled as Vijay & Others Vs. Narender & Others, pending before him having been remanded by the Collector, Jhajjar.

The anxiety of the petitioner is that though an order of remand was passed two years back but so far it has not been listed for hearing and disposal. He has, thus, prayed that a direction may be issued to respondent No.2, who is seized of the aforesaid case, to decide the same as early as possible, preferably within a period of three months.

Keeping in view the prayer made by the petitioner, we do not find any reason to issue notice to the respondents at this stage as the petitioner is only asking for early decision of the matter pending before respondent No. 2. Accordingly, present petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2, who is seized of the aforesaid case, to take a decision either way as early as possible but preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
