This order shall dispose of above mentioned two petitions.

CRM-M-10073-2019 has been filed under Section 439 (2)

Cr.P.C. for cancellation of bail granted to respondent No.2 in FIR No.20
dated 03.12.2015 registered under Sections 420/120 IPC (offence under
Sections 406/465/467/468/471 IPC added later on) at Police Station NRI,

SAS Nagar (Mohali) vide order dated 21.12.2018 passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, SAS Nagar (Mohali).

And **CRM-M-37829-2018** has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.20 dated 03.12.2015 registered under Sections 420/120-B IPC at NRI Wing, SAS Nagar, District Mohali.

Today counsel for respondent No.2 in **CRM-M-10073-2019** states that his client had given a cheque of Rs.8.50 lakhs which was dishonoured but he is ready to make that payment.

As regards the bail of the petitioner in **CRM-M-37829-2018** learned counsel has argued that his client has paid much more amount than was actually due from him and rather the other partner's share has also been paid by him.

Counsel for the complainant has argued that both these persons have not only cheated the complainant but also have taken the Court for a ride because they have obtained bail on the pretext of making the payment and on two occasions they have not made the payment and that is why bail of petitioner-Joginder Singh Sidhu was previously cancelled.

In my opinion, it would be in the interest of justice to give one more opportunity to each of these persons to make the payment.

Resultantly, I grant time up-till 10.06.2019 to Devinder Pal Singh to make the payment of Rs.8.50 lakhs and time till 10.07.2019 to Gurmeet Singh to make the payment of Rs.25.50 lakhs. In the event that these payments are not made by the date/s mentioned above the bail would be automatically cancelled.

Both the petitions stand disposed of.

Since the main cases have been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
