The petitioner is aggrieved of the communication dated 30.4.2015 (Annexure P-5) issued by the Indian Oil Corporation and in terms of which the application of the petitioner for award of Retail Outlet Dealership in between KM stone 33 and 35 on SH 32 Jeewan Nagar to Dudianwaly road, district Sirsa under open category, has been rejected.

Counsel would submit that in the impugned letter itself an option had been given to the petitioner to make a representation within 10 days. Case projected is that a representation was duly filed within the stipulated time frame but no decision thereupon has been taken.

Counsel representing respondent no.2 would take a stand that the representation dated 2.6.2015 (Annexure P-7) which the petitioner asserts had been filed was never received by the respondent-Corporation. Be that as it may a very fair stand has been taken that a decision would be taken on the representation by passing a detailed speaking order within a period of six weeks from today and the same would be communicated to the petitioner.

In the light of such fair stand taken on behalf of the respondent-Corporation, there would be no necessity for this Court to examine the validity of the impugned rejection order dated 30.4.2015 (Annexure P-5).

Writ petition is disposed of.

Needless to observe that this Court has not examined the case on merits.
