ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.189 dated 24.08.2018, under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B of IPC, 1860 registered at Police Station City Moga, District Moga.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is alleged in the FIR that there is a dispute between the parties with regard to the purchase of a truck. The petitioner is alleged to have not made the payment.

A coordinate Bench of this Court, by the order dated 07.03.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Sardara Singh, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 07.03.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
