Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 0003, dated 03.01.2019, under Sections 304-B, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Mauli Jagran, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 23.05.2019 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned proxy counsel for U.T., Chandigarh, on instructions from SI Dharamjit, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no more required at this stage.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and his

custodial interrogation is no more required, present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 23.05.2019 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
