Challenge in the present appeal has been directed against concurrent findings recorded by the courts whereby suit for permanent injunction restraining the respondents-defendants from shifting or disconnecting electric tubewell/ submersible motor connection bearing No. MA 139 15 HP and further restraining them from interfering in peaceful enjoyment of the aforesaid electric connection allegedly installed in joint land, detailed in head note of the plaint, was dismissed by the trial court vide judgment and decree dated 20.7.2018. Appeal preferred by unsuccessful appellant-plaintiff came to be dismissed by the Additional District Judge, Jalandhar whereby findings of the trial court were affirmed without variance.

The Court in Appeal has noticed certain admissions/facts on record, sufficient to negate plea of the appellant that land is joint or connection in question was installed in joint land. Counsel has failed to advance any arguments much less meaningful to make out a case that consistent findings recorded by the courts suffer from an error much perversity, warranting intervention.

In view of what has been discussed hereinbefore, finding no merit, the appeal fails and is accordingly dismissed in limine.
