Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that although a complaint dated 21.7.2018 (Annexure P-1) had been made to the police for taking action against Avtar Singh and others but no action had been taken thereupon, although a period of more than 6 months had elapsed thereafter.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Barnala (respondent No.3) to look into the matter and to dispose of the complaint dated 21.7.2018 (Annexure P-1) expeditiously. In case the allegations leveled therein are found to be well founded then necessary steps warranted under law be taken thereupon at the earliest.
