AVNEESH JHINGAN, J. (Oral)

Pursuant to order dated 24.9.2019, Mr. Parveen Kumar, Additional Deputy Commissioner (D), Barnala (since retired) and Mr. Inderjit Singh, DPI, Elementary Education are present in Court.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from Mr. Inderjit Singh, submits that payment of ₹3,01,126/-, i.e. share of the employer of the Contributory Provident Fund has been made vide cheque No. 000074 dated 15.10.2019.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that he is not in a position to contradict the said fact due to lack of instructions. However, he seeks liberty to avail remedies available in accordance with law in case

there is dispute with regard to the amount deposited.

In view of the statement made, the contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.
