Petitioner was appointed as data entry operator purely on contract basis in the year 2012 in the office of Civil Surgeon, Amritsar. At present, petitioner is stated to be working in the office of Civil Surgeon, Tarn Taran. He is aggrieved by order dated 25.1.2019 whereby he has been transferred from Tarn Taran to Hoshiarpur. It is evident that appointment of the petitioner is purely contractual in nature. Perusal of appointment letter Annexure P/1 shows that he was appointed on a consolidated remuneration of Rs. 8500/-. Admittedly, petitioner is not governed by any service rules. The concerned authority was fully competent to dispense with the services of the petitioner in terms of clause 7 of the appointment letter. However, he has been retained in service. Only his place of posting has been changed. There is no ground to interfere in the writ jurisdiction.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be allowed to withdraw this petition with liberty to pursue his representation. Petition is disposed of with liberty to pursue his representation.
