Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.141 dated 20.12.2018 under Sections 498-A, 406 IPC, registered at Police Station Division No.II, District Pathankot.

Vide order dated 20.03.2019, while staying arrest of the petitioner, the matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court and the parties were directed to appear before the Mediator on 08.04.2019.

Pursuant to the aforesaid order, parties have appeared before the Mediator and the settlement/compromise dated 08.04.2019 has been entered into between the parties.

Learned counsel for the complainant-respondent No.2 does not dispute the factum of settlement/compromise.

In view of the fact that the matter has been settled between the parties before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre and the settlement/compromise has been reduced into writing, the interim order dated 20.03.2019 is made absolute.

In case, the police finds that the petitioner is required in the present FIR, a clear 07 days' notice would be given to him.

The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
