The complainant-Ram Mehar has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking further investigations from the CBI or Senior Police Officers in case FIR No.197 dated 09.07.2012 for offences under Sections 365, 302, 201 and 34 IPC registered at P.S. Sadar Hansi, District Hisar regarding kidnapped child Ravi, even after the alleged accused have been acquitted by the Court of learned Additional Sessions Judge, Hisar, vide order dated 22.03.2016.

Upon notice by this Court, a reply by the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Hansi stands filed wherein it is stated that upon the needle of suspicion pointed out by the complainant the two accused Sandeep and Atma Ram were arrested and put up for criminal trial, which has, however, led to judgment of acquittal dated 22.03.2016.

Learned State counsel points out that the findings of

the acquittal have been affirmed by this Court while dismissing the appeal bearing CRM-A-1361-MA-2016 filed by the complainant vide order dated 06.09.2016. He further points out that the present petition has been filed after the dismissal of the appeal filed by the complainant.

After hearing counsel for the parties and keeping in view the facts of this case, no case for directing the further investigations is made out.
