Prayer is for quashing of FIR No.310, dated 28.07.2015, registered under Sections 420/467/468/471/120-B IPC, at Police Station Sector 11, Chandigarh and all other subsequent proceedings.

It is not in dispute that investigations even after lapse of more than 4 years have not been completed. There is no explanation as to why the investigations have not been completed.

Be that as it may, unless the investigations are complete, this Court, in the facts and circumstances of the present case, is not inclined to interfere, at this stage.

Hence, the petition is disposed of being pre-mature with liberty to the petitioners to file fresh one once the investigations are complete.

In the facts and circumstances of the present case, the Investigating Agency is directed to complete its investigations within a period of 2 months.
