Petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No.66 dated 03.05.2014 under Sections 279, 304-A, 427 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Division No.8, Jalandhar, District Jalandhar City (Annexure P-1) along with all consequential proceedings on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).

In this case, one person lost his life due to rash and negligent driving of truck driven by the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that there is a Division Bench judgment that compromise in offence under Section 304-A IPC is not permissible but review is pending.

After arguing some time, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition at this stage with liberty to re-file the same if the law is laid down by this Court that compromise is

permissible in such cases.

Dismissed as withdrawn at this stage with the liberty aforesaid.

Amount of Rs.10,000/- towards litigation expenses deposited in favour of the respondents No.2 & 3, be released to them in equal shares.
