MAHESH GROVER, J.(O)

States that he would be entitled to refund as the mining lease was granted to him on a misrepresentation of the area and the material available to the petitioner for mining.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that this Court has already directed the respondents to refund the amount while disposing of CWP-27711-2018. He further states that he would be satisfied if the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to consider the grievance as raised in the petition by giving an opportunity of hearing to him in the light of what has been observed in the judgment passed in the aforesaid writ petition.

We would, therefore, without commenting on the merits of the case, deem it appropriate to dispose of the present petition without issuing notice to the respondents at this stage but with a direction to respondent No.1 to decide the issue raised by the petitioner in the present petition by giving an opportunity of hearing as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the

order. Ordered accordingly.
