Prayer made in the petition is for quashing of FIR No.34 dated 5.4.2009 under Sections 427, 506, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25/27 of the Arms Act registered at Police Station Valtaha, District Tarn Taran and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of the compromise.

As per the report submitted by the trial Court, the parties have entered into valid and genuine, without any influence. The trial Court has also recorded that on an earlier occasion, the police submitted a cancellation report, which was accepted by the then Judicial Magistrate 1<sup>st</sup> Class, Patti on 10.9.2010. However, it appears that the parties were not aware of the same and, therefore, this petition is filed.

In view of the report submitted by the trial Court, the FIR is deemed to be cancelled in view of the acceptance of the cancellation report submitted by the police.

The present petition stands disposed of, accordingly.
