Learned counsel for the petitioner asserts that the order dated 30.10.2018 (Annexure P-2) passed by the Deputy Commissioner-cum-District Collector, Hoshiarpur, is not sustainable as he should have, in the light of the fact that he has come to a conclusion that the Court did not have the jurisdiction to hear the appeal, returned the same to the petitioner instead of dismissing the same.

Having considered the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, I do not find myself in agreement with him. The order dated 30.10.2018 (Annexure P-2) passed by the Deputy Commissioner-cum-District Collector, Hoshiarpur, is absolutely right and no interference is called for.

Petition stands dismissed.

Petitioner, if so advised, may avail of his remedy in accordance with law.
