Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing the order dated 17.10.2016 (Annexure P-2) passed by learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Batala, in FIR No.34 dated 23.04.2016 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 304-B, 120-B IPC (the offences were later replaced with Sections 306, 376 IPC) at Police Station Ghoman, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur, whereby the petitioners were declared as Proclaimed Offenders.

Counsel for the petitioners has argued that the other co-accused in the case who have faced the trial, have been acquitted by the trial Court vide judgment dated 21.03.2017 (Annexure P-3). He states that the

states that still the petitioners are ready to appear before the trial Court and to face trial in accordance with law.

At this stage, learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.2 states that even otherwise the matter has been compromised between the parties.

Be that as it may, but considering the fact that the petitioners have shown inclination to appear before the trial Court and to face trial, the present petition is disposed of with a direction that in case the petitioners appear before the trial Court within one month from today, the trial Court shall admit them on bail subject to their furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to its satisfaction.
