At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the police has already submitted a cancellation report on 19.03.2018 and since respondent No.3/complainant has raised an objection to the same on 12.03.2019 that he is not agreeing to the cancellation report, submitted by the police and intends to file a protest petition, the case was adjourned.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that this petition may be disposed of with a direction to the trial Court to decide the protest petition expeditiously.

In view of the limited prayer of the petitioner, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the trial Court/Illaqia Magistrate that in case a protest petition is filed by respondent No. 3/complainant (if it is not filed till date) within a period of one month from today, the same shall be decided expeditiously.
