The present contempt petition is filed for non-compliance of the directions issued by this Court on 13.2.2013 passed in CWP No. 12133 of 2007.

Admittedly, the contempt petition for non-compliance of the said order was dismissed on 10.10.2018 vide Annexure P-6. Learned counsel for the petitioner, however, while justifying the second contempt petition submitted that the said contempt petition was dismissed in view of the instructions dated 4.5.2018 but the said instructions have not been complied with and, therefore, the second contempt petition was maintainable. However, a perusal of the order dated 10.10.2018 shows that the learned Single Bench while dismissing the case specifically noted the argument of the learned counsel for the petitioner that the instructions have not been given effect to by the concerned department and dismissed the contempt petition by holding that the same was not in the scope of the

present contempt petition and also held that the order has been fully complied with. Thus, the present contempt petition being on the same cause of action is dismissed.
