Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of direction to the respondents to release the vehicle of the petitioner bearing registration No.PB-02-AC-9709 seized and detained on 21.09.2016, while invoking the provisions of Section 207(1) of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988. In the alternative, prayer has been made for a direction to respondent No.2 to take decision on his representation dated 04.02.2019 (Annexure P-1).

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the present petition may be disposed of in view of the order passed by this Court in **CRM-M-47615-2017** dated 16.08.2018 titled as ***Harish Kumar Vs. State of Punjab and others (Annexure P-4)***.

Considering the alternative prayer of the petitioner, respondent No.2-The District Transport Officer, Amritsar or the competent authority concerned of the Transport Department, Punjab, is directed to go through the grievance of the petitioner and to pass a speaking order as regards

release or non-release of the petitioner's vehicle within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

The present petition is accordingly disposed of in view of the order ***Annexure P-4***.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
