Upon hearing the two sides and perusal of the records. As is stated by the learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Narinder Singh, Police Station Sadar Gohana, no other case/complaint against the petitioner has been filed except FIR No.95 dated 08.04.2018 under Sections 354, 452, 506 IPC pertaining to Police Station Sadar Gohana, in which the petitioner is already on bail.

Keeping in view the apprehension expressed by learned counsel for the petitioner that there is every likelihood that the petitioner might be arrested by the concerned police, it would subserve the ends of justice if necessary directions are issued to the official respondents that in case the petitioner is required in any case/complaint against him, a seven days' clear notice be given to him in writing to enable him to have his legal recourse.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
