Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.265 dated 15.11.2018, registered at Police Station City Faridkot, District Faridkot, under Sections 306 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

As per the FIR, Sadhu Ram, father-in-law of complainant-Kaushlya Devi was residing with her. The neighbours Hans Raj, Usha Rani (present petitioner), Ravinder Kumar and Dharamvir @ bobby used to obstruct the complainant party from draining out the dirty water. All

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these accused persons threatened Sadu Ram for restraining him to construct a drain and to implicate him in a false case. Sadhu Ram committed suicide by taking some poisonous substance and a suicide note is also there.

Challan has already been presented. The petitioner has been in custody since 15.11.2018. She is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as she is in judicial custody. The trial of the case may take a long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to her furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
