The petitioner before this Court is one of the resident of Sandhu colony which is not a approved colony. The District Administration has already got FIR registered against the developers/colonizers. Prayer in this petition is to direct free and fair investigation. Some facts have already been noticed while deciding CRM-M-31705 of 2018 today itself.

Keeping in view the fact that there are more than 400 families who are residing in an unauthorized colony and there are serious allegations of sale of land which was earmarked for roads and parks as also there are allegations that some part of the common land which is Shamlat land has also been including, therefore, Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala is directed to personally supervise the investigation and make a sincere endeavour to get it completed within a period of 6 months as FIR was registered more than three years ago.

In view thereof, the petition is disposed of.
